

What to do if your home suffered some income significant changes or have any exceptional circumstances and you are not eligible for the maximum Pell grant?

Many FAFSA® applicants experience significant financial changes. These can be reviewed by an official from the Financial Aid Office, to assess if you qualify for a professional judgment. These changes can be due to:

- income loss
- income reduction

Exceptional circumstances include:

- Tuition fees paid to elementary or secondary schools (does not include the student).
- Non-reimbursable medical expenses (deductibles, copays and/or coinsurance paid)

If you believe you qualify for professional judgment evaluation, you must follow these steps:

1. Contact the Financial Aid Office to receive guidance and verify if you qualify.
